District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for June 2019**

**EMERGENCY ACTIVITY**

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to 171 calls between May 25th – June 30th, 2019 including 97 Medical Aids, and 21 Traffic Collisions; 6 incidents were reported as Fire, 7 as Hazardous; 21 as Public Service Assists; and 19 as false alarms.

Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 4 times between May 25th – June 30th, 2019.

**ADMINISTRATION**

2. On June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Office Technician Carrie Young completed the Emergency Incident Awareness class at the South Bay Training Center. In addition to this hands-on class, she completed the National Incident Command System courses IS-100, IS-700, and IS-800 online.
3. On June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Office Technician Carrie Young, attended the local quarterly Administrative Fire Services Section meeting. This was hosted by Five Cities Fire Authority in Arroyo Grande.
4. Station 15 – South Bay staff continued the budget preparation process through the month of June. Time was spent ensuring that the current budget was accurate and valid to provide a solid foundation for the next fiscal year budget.

**FIRE PREVENTION**

5. During the month of June, 2019 Station 15 – South Bay Reserve Firefighters inspected lots in the District for violations to the Hazardous Vegetation Ordinance No. 2019-01. In total, 610 violations were found and notices were sent to the property owners. They were given four weeks to correct the violations.

**SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS**

6. On June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Station 15 – South Bay participated in the third annual community Fire Preparedness Town Hall Meeting. This was a gathering of multiple First responders, adjoining agencies from Los Osos, and community committees to discuss emergency awareness in Los Osos.
7. On June 25, 2019, Station 15 – South Bay visited Book Buddies Daycare in Los Osos. The group consisted of approximately fifteen children ranging between the ages of two and four. They provided a tour of Medic Engine 15, along with basic fire safety tips. At the end of the day they were sent home with fire hats, stickers, and other trinkets.
8. During the month of June, 2019 Fire Apparatus Engineer Daniel Hauer began upgrading the lights around the exterior of the firehouse. This will allow adequate safety lighting for night drills conducted at Station 15 – South Bay.
9. During the month of June, 2019 Fire Apparatus Engineer Jim Green repainted the parking lines inside and in front of Station 15 – South Bay. This is done annually to keep the Station looking its best.
10. During the month of June, 2019 Chief George Huang was interviewed and featured in the Estero Bay News discussing the benefits behind the community organized Fire Preparedness Town Hall Meeting.

### **TRAINING**


11. During the month of June, 2019 Captain John Pearl completed the necessary requirements and became a Field Training Officer. He can now evaluate Firefighter EMT Paramedics county wide.
12. During the month of June, 2019 Sean Hanlon and Jonathan Huffman candidates successfully completed the Rookie Academy. They are now cleared for work at Station 15 – South Bay.

### **EQUIPMENT**

13. During the month of June, Apparatus Engineer Jim Green researched buyback options for the retired SCBA equipment that we replaced last year. During this process he was unable to find an outlet to sell the equipment due to the fact that they are outdated. We will be joining San Luis Obispo County Fire Department by donating the equipment back to the supplier to be re-purposed for other agencies unable to afford new equipment.

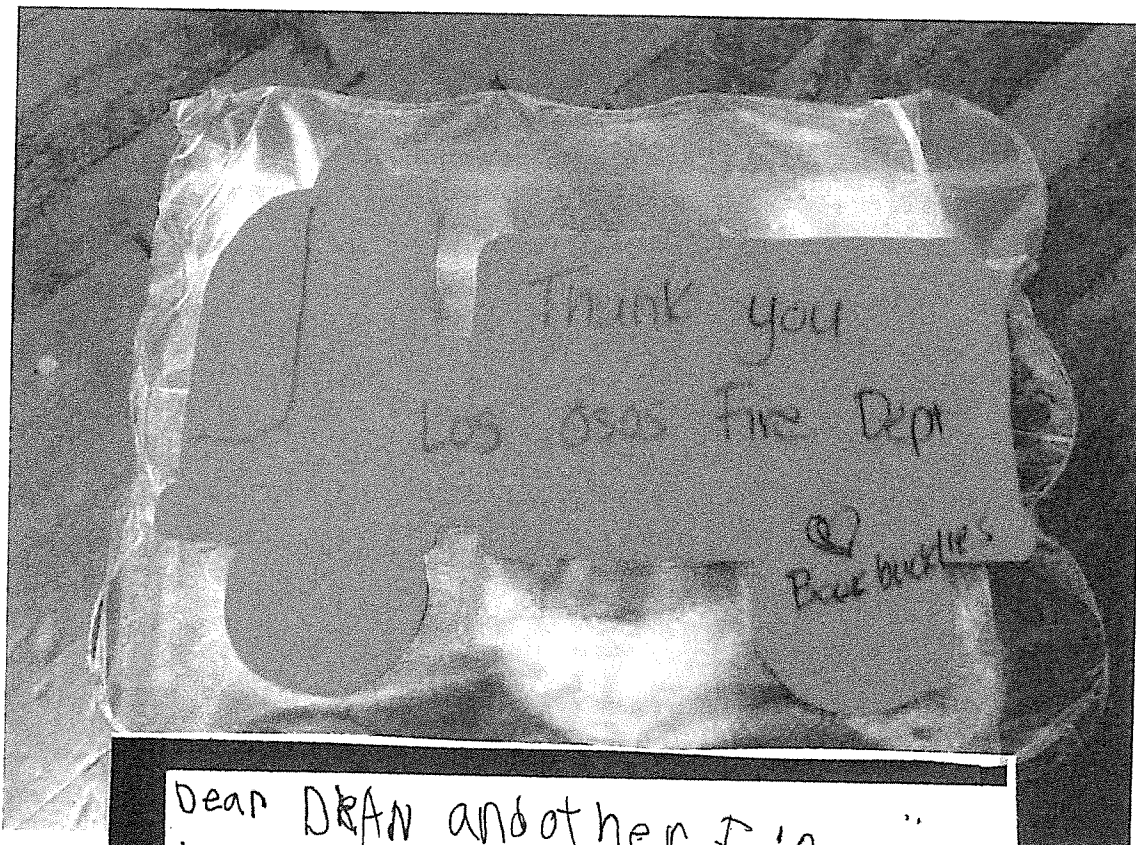
