Agenda Item 4A – March 1, 2018 Board Meeting District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for January 2018

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

- 1. Station 15 South Bay responded to 115 calls in January, including 89 Medical Aids; 13 incidents were reported as Fire; 13 as Public Service Assists.
- 2. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies in the month of January a total of 11 times.

ADMINISTRATION

- 3. During the month of January, all Station 15 South Bay Reserve Firefighters successfully completed their Annual Respiratory Protection Plan Medical Evaluations. Upon completion of this annual review, Reserve Firefighters will receive their annual Self Contained Breathing Apparatus Fit Test. This test ensures that SCBAs are worn safely when working in dangerous atmospheres.
- 4. In January, all Reserve Firefighters signed the 2018 Reserve Firefighter Employment Contract. The Contracts were then signed by Chief Alex and General Manager Osborne and placed in the Personnel Files.
- 5. The eight prospective Station 15 South Bay Reserve Firefighter candidates continued completing steps needed to become employees of the LOCSD. In January, all of the candidates successfully completed the Station 15 Rookie Taskbook and signed up for their required shadow shifts. In order to streamline this process and unify instruction, candidates attend a two day Station 15 South Bay Rookie Academy. At the Rookie Academy, candidates learned station specific guidelines and procedures for both routine station maintenance as well as emergency response.
- 6. On January 15, 2018, Reserve Firefighter George Meert resigned after 3 years of service to the community of Los Osos. George accepted a permanent Firefighter position with Bakersfield City Fire. In his resignation letter, George stated "I will truly miss my time at the station and being a part of the South Bay Family. I believe that I would not be the firefighter I am today without my time at 15. Thank you all for mentoring me throughout my time as a reserve, to seasonal, to career firefighter."

ADMINISTRATION

7. On January 29, 2018, Reserve Firefighter Christian Evers resigned after 5 years of service to the community of Los Osos. Christian accepted an internship at an international art studio in Guadalajara, Mexico and hopes to return to the area next year. Christian was a valuable asset, conducting CPR trainings, participating in several water rescues and mentoring many Reserves. He was awarded the 2018 Reserve Firefighter of the Year Award by his peers.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

- 8. On January 12, 2018, Station 15 South Bay celebrated the successes of 2017 at Nichols Pizza–n–Grill. Reserve Firefighters Stanley Craig and John Robson were also recognized by the Department for their 10+ years of service to community of Los Osos.
- 9. On January 23, 2018, Station 15 South Bay visited Village Preschool and met with approximately 40 kids, ages 2-5 years old. Firefighters provided a tour of Medic Engine 15 and Medic Rescue 15, along with basic fire safety tips.

TRAINING

- 10. From January 10 through January 12, 2018, Fire Captain-Paramedic Ciecek along with about 25 other CAL FIRE employees attended a 24 hour Continued Professional Training course taught by CAL FIRE/SLO County Fire Department Training Staff. This refresher course trained participants in auto extrication, rescue systems for ropes and ladders, CPR Training and numerous other topics. This is the 1st of 4 mandatory 24 hour annual training sessions for all CAL FIRE personnel.
- 11. On January 30, 2018, Station 15 South Bay Reserve Firefighter Denver Chavez provided Extinguisher Flash Pan training to the Estero Bay C.E.R.T. Team.

FIRE PREVENTION

12. On January 11, 2018, Battalion Chief Alex co-sponsored a Fuel Reduction Meeting to discuss hazard mitigation solutions within Los Osos. This meeting was attended by many concerned citizens, as well as qualified professionals.
