Utilities Department Report for November 2021

Utility Department Updates

Program C Well

The Minor Use Permit required for the project was submitted to the County October 8th. The 30-day County review period has passed without requesting additional information so the project has been accepted by default. During November, the project gained approval from the Basin Management Committee and the Los Osos Community Advisory Council. A grant application was submitted to the California Department of Water Resources (DWR) for approximately \$1.6 million is still pending. Staff has been in contact with DWR and has been told the District will be provided an update on the grant submittal by mid-December.

8th St. Upper Aquifer Well

The start date of the project is still to be determined but the contractor has indicated that some work may begin in January 2022. There have supply chain issues mainly with the electrical components of the project. Staff will keep the Committee apprised on the final project schedule when available.

16th Street South Tank Rehab and Coating Project

The District issued the Notice of Award to Paso Robles Tank and received the signed agreement and bond requirements on November 24th. The Notice of to Proceed was issued on November 29, 2021. The project is slated to be completed by March 2022.

Five Year Capital Improvement Plan Review

As we approach the half way point in the fiscal year, staff wanted to review the progress of the current fiscal year's capital plan and look at the bigger picture, five-year Capital Improvement Plan with the committee. The purpose of the review is to provide the committee with a better understanding of the needs of the water system and supporting facilities, and the priorities that staff has set in scheduling the projects over time.

All the projects listed in the attach five-year Capital Improvement Plan are from the 2013 updated Water Master Plan. As you can see, some projects are yet to be scheduled into the plan. Staff is currently working to determine the project that will be slated for construction in fiscal year 2026-2027. As with most plans, changes have been and will change according to shifting priorities. Additionally, some of the project cost estimates will need to be updated especially since the cost for materials have escalated significantly over the last year.
