District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for January 2020**

**EMERGENCY ACTIVITY**

1. Station 15 - South Bay responded to 104 calls between January 1 – January 27, 2020 including 58 Medical Aids, and 7 Traffic Collisions; 5 incidents were reported as Fire, 4 as Hazardous; 17 as Public Service Assists; and 13 as False Alarms.

Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 10 times between January 1 – January 27, 2020.

**ADMINISTRATION**

2. During the month of January, Chief Huang worked alongside Fire Marshall Chief Veyna to finalize the Fire Code. The 2020 Edition of the Fire Code contains regulations consistent with nationally recognized accepted practices for safeguarding, to a reasonable degree, life and property from the hazards of: Fire and explosion. Hazardous conditions in the use or occupancy of buildings or premises.
3. During the month of December Station 15 – South Bay staff continued the mid-year budget preparation process. Time was spent ensuring that the current budget was accurate and make any adjustments needed through the end of the fiscal year.

**TRAINING**

4. On January 28, 2020, Station 15 – South Bay Reserve Firefighters provided Extinguisher Flash Pan training to the Estero Bay C.E.R.T. Team.


**SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS**

5. On January 7, 2019, Station 15 – South Bay hosted a Cub Scout group meet up at the Station with approximately 13 kids, ages 7-11 years old. Firefighters provided a tour of Medic Engine 15 and Medic Rescue 15, along with basic fire safety tips.

6. On January 18, 2020, Station 15 – South Bay celebrated the successes of 2019 at Sea Pines Golf Resort. Reserve Firefighters Stanley Craig, Christian Evers and Connor Smith were also recognized by the Department for their 5+ years of service to community of Los Osos.
7. On Friday January 24, 2019 Station 15 – South Bay Firefighters walked along side Palp Alto Firefighter John Preston during his walk to raise awareness for PTSD in regards to first responders and veterans.

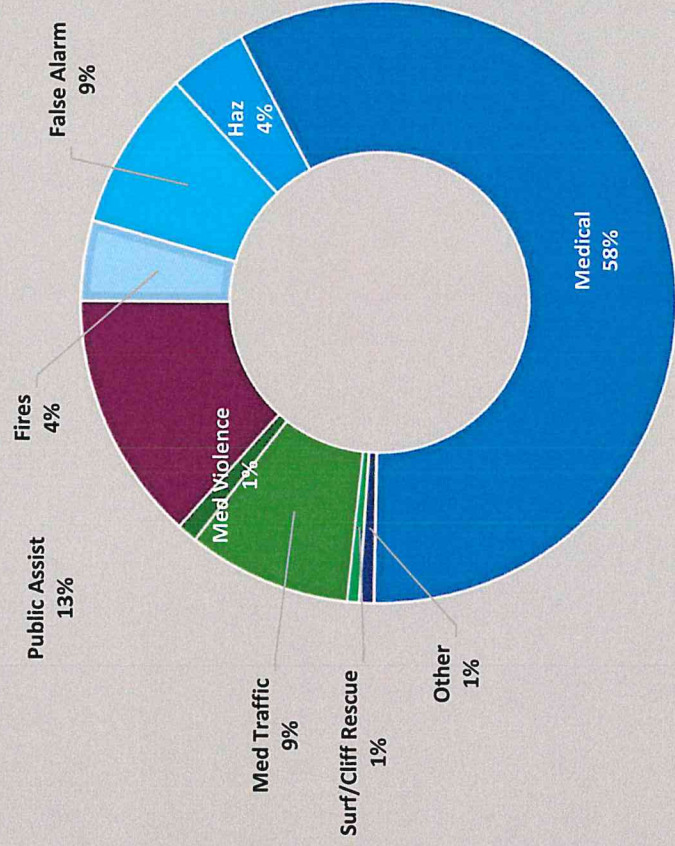

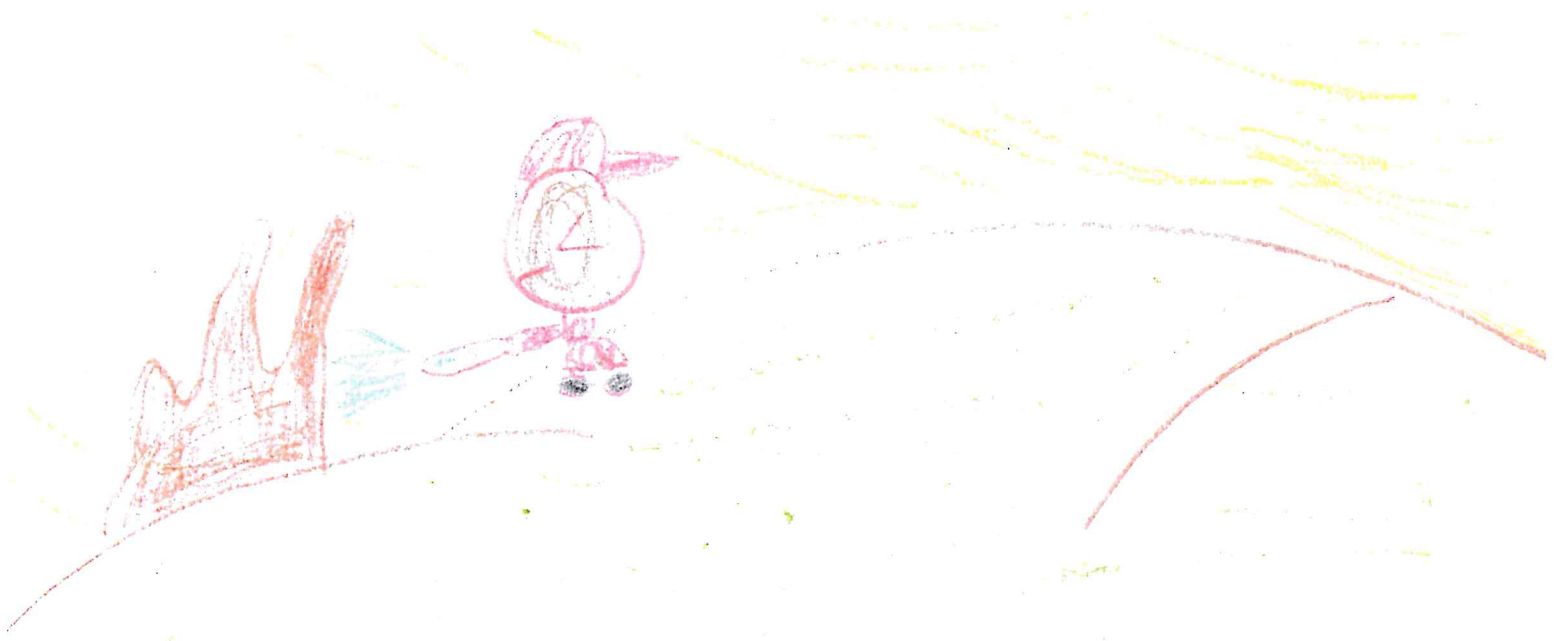
