The name Los Osos, which means "the bears" in Spanish, was officially given by the Post Office in July, 1914 to the communities of Los Osos, Baywood Park, and several other residential areas.

Los Osos/Baywood Park is nestled along the Southern tidal estuary of Morro Bay on the rugged coast of Central California. The town is a short 30 minute drive from San Luis Obispo through oak agricultural and cattle grazing countryside, a short 3 mile drive from Morro Bay (home of the well-known Mirano Books and just a few hours drive from several major metropolitan areas).

With a population of approximately 15,000, the town is situated on land that rises from a low level to 345 feet above sea level. Los Osos/Baywood Park offers a full complement of service clubs, organizations and activities, all of which support the quality of life that makes our community unique.

There are two elementary schools and one middle school in Los Osos/Baywood Park, and a high school in nearby Morro Bay. You'll also find a park, tennis courts, a library and a community center. The town has its own
