Approve Payment to the County of San Luis Obispo to Cover the Shortfall in the Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Fire Protection Services

Agreement Payment

DESCRIPTION

The District will need to make a loan to the County in the amount of \$41,636.03 to cover the shortfall in the Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Fire Protection Services payment.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Motion: I move that the Board approve the payment to the County of San Luis Obispo in the amount of \$41,636.03 to complete the Cal Fire payment contract.

DISCUSSION

The County did not hold back enough of the property tax (Zone B) to cover the final Cal Fire payment that is due on June 30, 2018. Since it is 100% our responsibility to make sure this payment is on time, we need to send back some of the property tax that Fire has received in order to make the payment to Cal Fire in a timely manner. The County has made provisions to adjust their percentage of retention of property tax for zone B to avoid this issue in the future.

Per the County:

"The amount <u>estimated</u> for \$1,983,968 is the portion of the AB8 1% general tax that the (Fund 0748) Zone (b) Fire was expected to receive for the 17/18 year. Only 77.07% of these taxes were held, the rest were released monthly to Los Osos CSD for the Zone B Fire. We are requesting the CSD return a portion of the Zone B Fire money that was dispersed throughout the year to make the Cal Fire Payment."

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There shall be no financial impact to the 301 South Bay Fire Departments budget. Since we are a teetered community we will be receiving all of the scheduled property tax from the County.

Per the County:

"Yes, we are a teetered County and any tax bills that are unpaid will be paid off by the County and the CSD's portion sent to you as we close the year end books. Unfortunately, we can only legally "buy out" the taxes when the year is ready to close and we know exactly how much will be bought out (In mid-July). Since the Cal Fire payment usually paid in full in May, we cannot use this money for the payment, but the CSD will be getting this buy-out money with your monthly distribution for July."
