STAFF

- The remainder of the Audit was conducted on October 18th and 19th. The Auditor was satisfied with the District's organization and updated invoicing procedures. The Audit should be ready for Draft review at the December meeting.
- Utility Manager Acosta and I have been working on the removal of the Bayridge septic tanks. A report was presented to both the Utilities Advisory Committee and the Finance Advisory Committee for their review and recommendation to the Board. There is a full report under 12B for Board review and discussion.
- The District currently does not have a policy in place for the disposal of District assets (equipment, excess furniture, etc.). There is a draft policy for Board review under 12C.

PROP 1 GRANT FOR 8TH STREET WELL

The County received twenty-five (25) project submissions for the Prop 1 Grant funds. The County is still processing the grant submissions and do not have a projects list with scoring available. They hope to have the list completed by the November meeting.

The Department of Water Resources (DWR) has not posted the grant guidelines for the Prop 1 Grant process. Once the guidelines are posted the County/Districts will have a 45-day review period. This will allow us to determine if our project meets the DWR's requirements to receive funds from the Prop 1 Grant Funds.

STORMWATER GRANT FOR DRAINAGE CONCEPT

On February 19, 2018, the County sent out a call for stormwater and dry weather capture projects/concepts. The submission deadline was March 2, 2018. Staff quickly collaborated on a concept to submit to the County. Staff's Drainage concept has been approved by the County and ranked #2 among the other concepts and projects submitted to the County. The concept redirects stormwater from the outfall lines that lead to the Bay and the Estuary to the County's wastewater plant. Staff will compile a full concept report and submit a project request to the Board for their review and input.

LOS OSOS LOW INCOME ASSISTANCE FUND

We have five of the nine applicants sewer laterals completed. All five applicants have chosen to abandon their septic tanks. The remaining four applicants have their bids turned in and are in the process of getting their permits.

At the Boards request, we have extended the application process to December 31st. At this time, I have been contacted by one resident who is making an appointment with Lisa Gonzales to receive assistance with filling out the application. I will have a verbal update regarding the recommendation from the Finance Advisory Committee from their October 29th meeting regarding the General Manager's wage used to determine expenses.

Special District Risk Management Authority (SDRMA) CORRESPONDENCE

We received a letter from SDRMA to advise us that we received a credit (\$1530.22) towards our Worker's Compensation insurance for the 2017-2018 fiscal year. This credit was distributed among the funds in the 2017-2018 fiscal budget cycle.

We also received a "No Claim" recognition letter for the 2017-2018 fiscal year. Both letters are attached for Board review.

LOS OSOS COMMUNITY PARK PLAYGROUND RUBBER CHIP REMOVAL PROJECT UPDATE

The Los Osos Community Park Playground Rubber Chip removal was a success. Not only did we complete the project on time, we were also under budget. Madonna Construction donated their equipment and some of their operator's time, their bill came in at \$1800. Jet Mulch (\$12,123.19) and Mission Country Disposal (\$217.00) invoices came in at their budgeted costs.

We had a few issues during project implementation, but contingency plans were in place. The skid steer kept getting stuck in the soft sand and was not able to travel to the other side of the park to pick up the rubber chips on the north end. Plywood had to be used to help with entrance to the playground after the first day of work. Steve Best had plywood available so we did not have to use District funds for that purchase. I had the District's Vac Truck ready to go in case we had issues on the north end, so the Vac Truck was used. The receipts for running this equipment plus a new filter were charged to the Park Fund and totaled \$94.22.

There was a rain event on Wednesday, October 3rd which was to be the first day of fibar chip delivery and installation. Jet Mulch called in advance to let us know they would not be able to get into their yard to pull the chips and would not be here until Thursday. This postponed the fibar chip installment for one day. I included an extra day in the work schedule in case of any kind of delays. The volunteers and I used this day to our advantage for cleanup of the remaining rubber chips from the playground and parking lot. Madonna Construction worked an extra unexpected half day to assist with the remaining rubber chip removal which the District was not charged for. Had they charged us full cost for all two and a half days, our bill would have been about \$5,000 (operator time and equipment usage). Mission Country Disposal also donated the majority of their costs of this project. They hauled and disposed of 61.8 tons of rubber chip material (9 roll offs). Were it not for their donation of the disposal costs (\$4,727.70) and the actual hauling costs (\$1,953) we would have had to pay \$6,680.70. Attached is a list of actual expenses and receipts.

During the process of the project, we received several donations for the volunteers's food, snacks and water which totaled \$337.17. Attached is a list of those donors. Also, Grace Environmental donated the costs to run the Vac Truck (\$100), and one of the volunteers donated \$1,000 towards the project and would like to remain anonymous. I have submitted a donation request form to Supervisor Bruce Gibson's office to receive the \$1,000 donation he promised towards the project.

We also had many other items/donations from local business that contributed to our project: Starbucks, Miner's Hardware, SLO Roast Coffee, and Los Osos Miner's donated 60 respirator masks valued at \$150.00. The following people contributed food items: Ann Kudart, Jim Stanfill, and Jose Acosta.

Total cash donations: \$2,437.17

The volunteer commitment was the integral piece of the whole project. Without their dedication, determination and belief in this project, our costs would have been about \$30,000. We had thirty-seven (37) volunteers on Saturday, thirty (30) on Sunday, twenty-two (22) on Monday, twenty-six (26) on Tuesday, and six (6) on Wednesday morning which totaled four hundred and forty-eight (448) volunteer hours. Jennifer Foronjy, one of our Parks and Recreation committee members, put in a vast amount of time towards this project. She coordinated the volunteer list and made sure that we had enough bodies every single day. I wanted to give her special recognition for her devotion and commitment to making sure this project was successful. Our local contractors also deserve a special thank you. Nathan Lemieux, Eduardo Flores and Jeff Smith from Mission Country Disposal/Waste Connections, Richard Zimmerman, Garett Amos and John Madonna from Madonna Construction went above and beyond their scope of work to make sure that we remained on schedule and assisted us in keeping our costs down.

The Park Rangers/Safety Specialists from the County were there every day of the project. They assisted with contingencies and allowed us to make changes to our work plan as needed. They also purchased the base material and set it without adding costs to our project.

In total (contractors, material, food), the project cost was \$14,571.58. With donations of \$2,437.17, our costs were \$12,134.41. Our original projected costs were \$13,341.00. Attached is a full accounting of all receipts and donations.

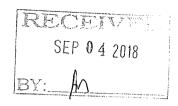

Dear Ms. Milledge:

This letter is to formally acknowledge the dedicated efforts of the Los Osos Community Services District's Governing Body, management and staff towards proactive risk management and loss prevention training. Your agency's efforts have resulted in no "paid" property/liability claims for program year 2017-18. A "paid" claim for the purposes of this recognition represents the first payment on an open claim during the prior program year and excludes property claims. This is a great accomplishment!

It is through the efforts of members such as Los Osos Community Services District that SDRMA has been able to continue providing affordable property/liability coverage to over 505 public agencies throughout California. In fact, 428 members or 85% in the property/liability program had no "paid" claims in program year 2017-18.

In addition to this annual recognition, members with no "paid" claims during 2017-18 earned 2 credit incentive points (CIPs) thereby reducing their annual contribution amount. Also, members with no "paid" claims for at least 3 consecutive program years may receive a lower "risk factor" which also reduces their annual contribution amount.

As SDRMA is dedicated to serving its members and preventing claims, we would appreciate your agency taking a moment and sharing with us what made your District successful in preventing property/liability losses. Our goal is to incorporate your successful ideas and suggestions into our loss prevention programs to benefit all members of SDRMA. 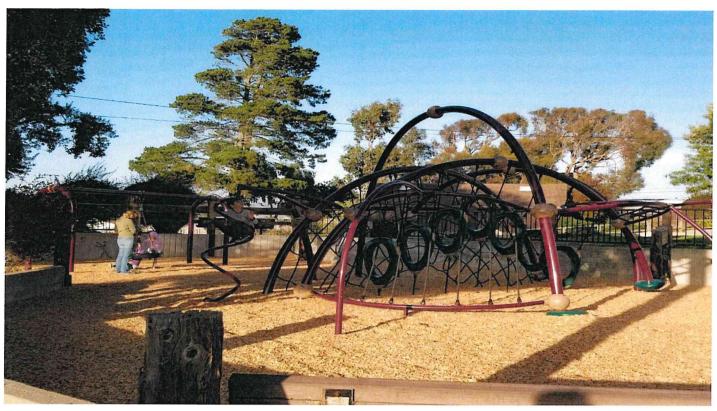
