District /CAL FIRE Chief Report for June 2022

EMERGENCY ACTIVITY

 Station 15 - South Bay responded to 166 calls between May 22, 2022 – June 21, 2022, including111 Medical Aids, 15 Traffic Collisions; 9 incidents were reported as Fire, 6 as Hazardous; 21 as Public Service Assists; and 4 as False Alarms. Company 15 was called to cover the station or respond to emergencies 8 times between May 22, 2022 – June 21, 2022.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

- 2. Station 15 South Bay has completed first round of vacant lot weed abatement inspections. Notices have been mailed.
- 3. CAL FIRE SLU, South Bay Fire, and San Luis Obispo County Fire Safe Council hosted a public chipping event for the Los Osos community on June 25th.
- 4. CAL FIRE SLU, Los Osos Community Service District, and the Toro Fire Center have started a fuels reduction project in the Bay Oaks neighborhood in the District open space area connected to State Parks Oaks Preserve. Project will address many of the Communities concerns regarding fuel loading in that area. Project will take 3-4 work days but will be at the mercy of Fire Season to be completed.
